RIVER ROAD WATER MAIN REPLACEMENT PROJECT

The Lower Mahanoy Township Municipal Authority has been awarded \$304,870 towards a water main replacement project along River Road, extending from Blacksmith Hill to Water Street and because of the bids received, will now also include Susanna Street to State Route 147. There will be at least 20 water customers who will receive new water services and at least 22 more water customers that will have some temporary interruptions of their water service during the project phase. Bids were opened on 6/10/2026 and the project is in the process of being awarded to Sikora Brothers Paving, Inc.

*****AUTOMATIC BILL PAY*****

For those customers of the Authority who have online banking, most financial institutions will have bill pay available to their customers at no cost. Please check with your bank as this could differ from institution to institution. Setting up a monthly automatic payment to the Lower Mahanoy Township Municipal Authority would eliminate the cost of late fees in case of forgetting to pay your water and sewer bill.

DAMAGE

Please contact the Authority Office immediately at 570-758-3615 if you discover that damage has occurred on either the water or wastewater system so that the proper repairs can be scheduled. The Authority would like to say thanks to those people who have taken the time to report damage and/or leaks. It is greatly appreciated.

POOL FILLING

If a consumer desires to fill or add water (300 gallons or more) to a swimming pool, the consumer must contact the Authority or its operator to obtain the written permission as to the time, date and amount of water which the consumer may use to fill or add to the pool and any restrictions that may be placed upon the water service at that time. If the consumer violates this provision, the water service to the property may immediately be terminated without prior notice and in addition, the violator shall be subject to the payment for the cost for termination or restoration of service, the actual or estimated amount of water used and a penalty of \$300 for damage to the water system. For more information, consumers may either contact the Municipal Office at 570-758-3615 or the plant operator at 570-274-0554 or you may send a request through our website under the "Services" tab and click Request from the drop down menu on the right top of the webpage. If you are not sure how much water your pool holds, under the "fill a pool" heading on the left side of the screen, there is place to calculate the amount of water needed.

CHANGE OF OWNERSHIP INSPECTION

Upon a proposed change of ownership of any Improved Property, the Owner shall notify the Secretary of the Authority, or his designee, at least five (5) days in advance of the intention to transfer or change ownership of an Improved Property. Upon notification, the Authority shall inspect the water and sewer connections for compliance with all provisions of the Rules and Regulations for water and sewer connections, which may be in effect at the time of the proposed change of ownership. If the water and/or sewer connections are not in compliance with the Rules and Regulations set forth at that time, the Owner shall immediately bring the water and/or sewer connections into compliance. A \$50 inspection fee shall be assessed. Upon completion of said inspection and any compliance issues, the Authority shall issue a certification of compliance.
